

FRC Downingtown Area Robotics (DAR) Team Permission Form

This form includes a lot of helpful and important information! Parents and students please read and reserve dates.

I, _____ (Student) and _____ (Parent) understand that most DAR team meetings are in the evening and weekends to accommodate mentor schedules, and I will provide my own transportation to the CCIU TCHS Brandywine Campus, 443 Boot Road, Downingtown, PA.

I understand that students will be operating under supervision power tools after training. I (student) promise to act responsibly in the machine shop, wear safety glasses, no dangling jewelry, and closed-toed shoes, and tie back loose hair and **obey all shop safety guidelines (explained in training).**

I understand the FRC meets Wed. 6:00-9:00PM September –December and March- July and 5-7 nights 6-9 PM weekdays and weekends (Sat. 10AM -8PM, lunch/dinner provided by parents, Sun. Noon -6PM) during the build season January 9- Feb 23, 2016. I understand that build work hours might increase as needed. I also understand that the team attends several local competitions on Saturdays in October - November and May-June, and will be attending two 2-Day In-season District Events and if qualified the Mid-Atlantic Robotics FRC Regional Championship and the FRC Championships in St. Louis, Missouri April 2016, overnight travel and stay). Team members will also be responsible to attend demos and fund raisers throughout the year. Competitions, demos, and fund raisers will be at participants cost. I (student) will take responsibility for obtaining make-up work from my teacher **BEFOREHAND** and turn it in on time.

I understand that there will be a student participation fee of \$425 for the first child in a family and \$225 for additional children in the same family, to help defray club costs. This will include the cost of 1 team vest.

I understand that I will get out of this program what I put into it, and the commitment I make is up to me. I also understand that I am responsible for keeping up with my schoolwork and need not attend every meeting during the build season.
